Friday – judging of exhibits 8:00 am – 10:00 am (closed to public during this time)

Open to the public from noon – 7 pm.

Saturday – **Open to the public from 10:00 am until 4:00 pm.**

All entries need to be picked up between 3:30 – 4:00 pm. Any items not picked up will be disposed of if perishable.

Rules:

Open to all age groups unless otherwise stated. Only items made since previous CSD should be entered. No premiums will be awarded. Each project will receive a ribbon.

Divisions:

Animal By-products – any item made from animals. Antlers, leather, soap, etc

Art – oil painting, charcoal, pencil, watercolor, or Crayola.

Canned goods – labeled and dated.

Craft I – recycle, reduce, reuse (any item made from a recycled item).

Craft II – any item hand made.

Craft III – items made under supervised direction. High School only.

Baked Goods – cookies, cakes, or breads (recipe and instructions should be included)

Flowers – potted, fresh cut, non-live arrangements. Categories—seasonal, creative, farm, plant.

Needle Work – any project such as needle point, embroidery, or cross-stitch.

Photography – scenery, people, or animals.

Sewing – any item that is hand-made using a needle and thread.

Quilts – hand made. Categories – baby, holiday, animal, wall hanging and patriotic.

Red Hat Decorating – Decorate your red hat with creativity and flare.

Vegetables – should be home grown and not purchased.

Wood Working – any item made by hand.
